\*There was not a V1 #8 or a V2 #12.

In the final issue (V3 #7), Pertec announced that it was moving the Computer Notes publishing headquarters from Albuquerque to California. However, no further issues were ever published.

All issues from V1 #1 through V2 #7 were in a large newspaper tabloid format.

All issues from V2 #8 through V2 #11 were magazine format.

All issues from V3 #1 through the final issue were in a slightly wider magazine format.

MITS published "Computer Notes Review 1" and "Computer Notes Review 2". These were replications of the significant articles and columns that had previously been printed in the Computer Notes periodicals. CN Review 1 included articles from V1 #1 through V2 #2. CN Review 2 included articles from V2 #3 through V2 #8.

The source of this data is my personal collection and investigation I've done over the years. It is believed to be accurate, but please let me know if you find any errors.
