His Byte Shop Sells **Computers for Home**

Business Editor Chet Harris operates a Byte Shop in San Mateo's Laurelwood Shopping Center. And no, the name of the

shop is not some Od Eng-lish way of spelling "bite." Nor is Harris's business a place you'd go for a quick meal

Although the people who do go there certainly must have healthy appetites. Harris expects them to spend "a minimum of \$3/4 million" with him — or

million" with him - or with his brother John at their other location in Southern California – dur-ing the next 12 months. What the business is –

as far as the Byte Shop itself is concerned — is the retail selling of mini-computers, along with assorted related paraphernalia and publications, for home and

And what "byte" means — leaving out the technical jargon — is a place of computer information. It's a relatively new

And, with operations like

the Byte Shop, it refers to a very new business field. As a matter of fact, Chet is San Mateo County's

is San Mateo County's pioneer in mini-computer retailing and his Laurel-wood outlet is just one year old. "To give you an idea of how new the whole field is," "he said, "the first retail store in the whole United States opened only a little more than a year ahead of me — in July, 1975, at Los Angeles."

1975, at Los Angeles." Now there are more than 500 including a second shop here — Computer Terminal in downtown San Mateo, where Termo and Poter run by Trone and Betty Miller — and many more on the drawing board, including one in Redwood City, Chet sald.

City, Chet said. But the growth isn't measured only in terms of numbers of stores. "Take our Byte Shop as an example," Chet said. "During our first three months in business, our sales arountied to shoul sales amounted to about

The Southern California location — in Orange County — is strictly whole-sale, and Chet said distrib-
